

Customer Letter from J. Christine to Oshawa Car Assembly Plant:

None of you know me, but a friend of mine was kind enough to give me your email addresses because I wanted to express my thanks to you for building and delivering - what is without a doubt - the finest car I've ever driven. I took delivery of my 2LT Aqua Blue Metallic Camaro on Thursday, July 23rd and I would have written this sooner, but I have been driving it ever since I got it (just over 1,500 miles on it as of today...).



I have always wanted a Camaro, but was never able to afford or justify buying one until now. In January 2006, I watched the unveiling of the Camaro Concept at the Detroit Auto Show and I told my wife that night that if they built it, that would be my next car. I was driving a Honda Accord at the time. Her response was "Yeah, right", but I kept up with the development and every morsel of information I could find in the news and on the internet and the obsession got worse. On October 18, 2008 I pre-ordered my car and started a 9 month, 5 day wait that was at times fun, and at other times frustrating, but last Thursday I sold my Honda and went to pick up my baby. I can't say enough about the fit and finish and overall workmanship that went into this car. I know you can churn out 300 to 400 cars a day, but it looks like mine was hand-built. Everyone that sees the car comments on how well-built it is and how good it looks. I had a guy run across two parking lots last night while I was filling it with gas because he saw me pull out of the restaurant parking lot and just had to see the car and talk to me about it. Another guy at a stop light was literally hanging out of his car window staring at the car and asking me questions about it and telling me how awesome it looked. I have to say that this car is more than a vehicle - it's a driving experience...

Anyway, I just want to thank you and all the folks at the plant who had a hand in building my car. It is an amazing machine and one that I plan to have for a very, very long time. That doesn't mean I won't buy another one (I'll want the Z-28 when it comes out...), but I plan on enjoying this one for quite awhile.
